HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said \_\_\_\_\_

J. F. Ashmore, all the right, title and interest of  
the minor defendant, Gabrella Brashier Malone, in  
and to the following described real estate, to-wit:

"All that certain parcel or tract of land, situate,  
lying and being in Fairview Township, County of  
Greenville, State of South Carolina, and containing  
thirty eight and 78/100 acres, more or less, and bounded  
as follows, on the north by lands of Mrs. Maggie  
Richardson and N. A. Henderson, on the east and  
south by lands of O. F. Henderson and Jenkins  
Bridge Road, and on the west by lands of Mrs.  
Maggie Richardson. This is the remainder of the fifty  
nine acre tract conveyed to J. P. Brashier by Edgar  
W. Peden by deed dated December 20th, 1919, and  
recorded in the R. M. O. Office for Greenville County  
in Vol. 55, page 119.

The said J. P. Brashier having previously  
conveyed about twenty acres of the fifty nine acre  
tract to O. F. Henderson, October 20th, 1925, by deed  
recorded in Volume 83, page 501 said R. M. O. Office.
