Annie Smith, her heirs and assigns forever;
All my right title and interest in and to all that certain piece parcel and tract of land lying and being situate in the County and State aforesaid, and in Austin Township, with the following notes and bounds, courses, and distances to-wit: Beginning at a stake in road at *Miss. Blanche* corner and running thence S 20 W 4.69 to the stone; thence S 53 1/2 W 21.52 to stone; thence S 54 W 2.70 to stone on north side of *Hilders Creek*; thence crossing a creek and running S 46 W 6.00 to stone; thence S 44 1/2 W 17.17 to stone; thence N 36 W 7.90 to stone on creek; thence crossing creek and running N 23 W 5.90 to stone; thence N 74 E 1.62 to stone; thence N 65 E 21.08 to stake in bottom; thence N 48 E 10.26 to stone; thence N 43 1/2 E 20.00 to iron pin on road; thence with said road S 51 E 7.74 to beginning corner, and containing 53 acres, more or less. This being the same tract of land conveyed to M. M. Gaines by J. M. Verdin by Deed dated January 20th. 1910, and recorded in the Office of R. M.
