(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said R. N. Gallamore, All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, about two miles from Greenville Court House State and county aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of an alley fourteen feet wide, on the west side of Goldsmith street one hundred and eighty-three feet from the corner of Goldsmith and Pierce streets, and running thence with Goldsmith street N. 48. 39 E. one hundred and twenty + two feet to an iron pin, thence N. 41. 30 W. one hundred and eighty-five feet to an iron pin, thence S. 45. 30 W. one hundred and twenty-two feet to a stake on an alley fourteen feet wide, thence with said alley, E. 41. 30 W. one hundred and eighty-five feet to the beginning corner, being lots no. 72 and 73 as shown on a plat of "Oakwood" made by J. E. Surine, March 6th, 1906, the above described lots were a portion of the land conveyed by J. W. Jenkins to Wm. D. Surine and Thos. J. Charles on the 24th day of February, 1906, deed recorded in the office of Register of Deeds, Conveyance for Greenville County in Book R. R. page 692, and conveyed to Piedmont Realty Company by said Wm. D. Surine and Thos. J.
