the receipt whereof, is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *E. F. Payne*, all of our undivided interest in and to all that certain piece or parcel of tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, of the Parish of St. James, according to a plat thereof prepared by W. Southern with date 11th day of 1885 and recorded in the office of the Clerk of Court of said County and State, in Judgment Book No. 21, page 212, to wit: Beginning at the middle of the Bridge where the Runway Road crosses Spuggel Creek, a tributary of North Carolina River, and running thence along said creek as a boundary between sections 20 and 21, about 2.00 ch. to a stone 3x3 in. Place at distance 27 1/2 ch. to a stone 3x3 in. in Alluvial corner, thence along said line 40 6/8 ch. to a stone 3x3 in. place of Peachnut Grove, thence N 75 3/4 E 12.25 ch. to a stone 3x3 in. M. S. 11.45 ch. to a stone 3x3 in. thence down the branch as a line following the meadow trees 25.00 ch. to a well 3x3 in. at mouth of Small Run or branch, thence continuing down the first meadow branch following the meadow trees 25.00 ch. to its confluence with Spring Creek, thence down said creek as the line between the meadows thence to the beginning corner, the total distance from the beginning back along fronted down said branch and creek to beginning corner, being about 20.00 ch. This is a portion of the land conveyed by John H. Woodruff to W. D. Woodruff as Trustee for J. Lightfoot Woodruff, by a deed bearing date July 26, 1886 and recorded in office of Register of Merne Comynance of said State and County on Aug. 16, 1886 in Book 21, page 212. Said tract of 758 1/2 acres having been partitioned among the heirs of the said J. Lightfoot Woodruff by decree of the court of Common Pleas for said State and County rendered July 13, 1887 in the case of W. D. Woodruff Trustee against Heirs of J. Lightfoot Woodruff et al in said partition tract No. 3 of said land containing 16.9 acres was allotted to John H. Woodruff and was conveyed to him by J. W. Day, Master for said County by deed bearing date September 13, 1887 and recorded in the last mentioned office on September 19, 1887 in Book 21, page 148 and being conveyed by the said John H. Woodruff to the said C. F. Payne by deed bearing date September 14, 1886 and recorded in said last mentioned office by the same day in Book 21, page 149. The tract hereinafter described by meter and bounds is supposed to contain about eighty (80) acres, more or less.
