Fattie H. Shackelford, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in the Fourth Ward of the City of Greenville, on the south side of East McFee Avenue; being a portion of the land conveyed by W.C. Cleveland to J.W. Norwood by deed dated June 28, 1911, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 12, page 99-100; and conveyed to me by the said J.W. Norwood by deed dated March 1921; and more fully described as follows:
