(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Viola M. Baker, her heirs and assigns, all of that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situate, lying and being in said city of Greenville State and County aforesaid, being Lot number 4-3-1 of the Overbrook subdivision, and having the following fixtures and appendages:

Beginning at a point just out the North West side of the Spartanburg Road (said line being the East corner lot number 4-2) and running N 58-25 W 25-3 feet to an iron post, thence N 58-37 C 103.6 feet to an iron post back, S 48-56 C 24.0 feet to another post on the Spartanburg Road; thence S 41.0 W 78.5 feet to an iron post the point of beginning, according to the plat of the Overbrook Land Company by H. Old, dated September 17, 1913 and of record in the Office of Register Deeds, Conveyance from Greenville County, in plat book "C" page 201, wherein said lot is erroneously numbered 63, but the North side of the Spartanburg Road.

This deed however is made subject to the following restrictions:

That the property herein conveyed shall not be conveyed to any person or persons of African descent;

That the main residence building erected thereon shall cost not less than twenty five hundred dollars and no more than thirty five from the property line on the Spartanburg Road.

This being one of the ten lots (4) conveyed to me by Overbrook Land Company by deed date March 4, 1914 and recorded in Book 25 Page 193.
