(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. C. Milford, All that lot of land at the Southeast corner of Hudson and Meadow streets in the City of Greenville State and County aforesaid and described as follows: Beginning at an iron post on the South bank of the Old Red or river of Reedy River at Hudson street and running thence with said street N. 22° 30' E. 8.19 to Meadow street; thence along the south side of Meadow street, N. 54° 15' W. 5.69 more or less to line of lot of Miss Battle Whitmire; thence with her line S. 39° 30' W. 4.86 more or less to an iron post on south side of said Reedy River old red or river; thence along the edge of said old red or river S. 33° E. 8.21 more or less to the beginning corner this being the same lot conveyed to me by J.
