Bull, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and in the City of Greenville, and being situate on the North side of West Washington Street and having a frontage on said West Washington Street of Seventy-seven (77) feet and eight (8) inches with same width in rear on John Street, and having a depth of Two hundred and eighty (280) feet, and containing one-half (1/2) acre, more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Marie G. Conyers by deed dated the 2nd, day of February 1920, which deed is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 66 at page 473.

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
