Henry H. Harris, All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of
Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the north side of Pendleton Street,
and being more particularly described as follows, according to a plat thereof prepared by C.M.-

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Pendleton Street, corner of Oak Lawn School Lot,
