all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

In Ward Two of the City of Greenville being the eastern portion of Lot no. 162, Block 62, East Park, part of Boyce Addition to the City of Greenville, according to a plat made by M. A. Adams, and recorded in Plat Book A page 383. Beginning at corner cross post on Syppay Avenue corner of lot no. 109, and running thence along Syppay Avenue in a northwesterly direction 30 feet to a stake; thence in a southeasterly direction 150 feet more or less, to a stake on a ten foot alley; thence with said Alley in a northeasterly direction 30 feet to corner of lot no. 109; thence with line of lot no. 109 in a northwesterly direction 149 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the beginning point on Syppay Avenue.
