all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Knows the city of Greenville in the sub-division known as "Kanawha" and known as lots #12 and #17 of Block "E" now revised plat of the said property recorded in the Office for said County. The said two lots in the aggregate, have the following metes and bounds: beginning at a stake on the south side of Burketon Street at corner of lot #11; said running thence along said street n. 56-21 E. one hundred and twenty-one feet to other at corner of lot #14; thence along said lot about 25-51 E. one hundred and fifty feet to stake at corner of lot #5; thence along said lot said lot #4, one hundred and twenty feet to stake at corner of lot #11; thence along said lot about n. 25-51 W. 134.8 feet to the beginning point on said Burketon Street.
