all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

near the Augusta Road, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 47, 48, 51, 52, 53 and 54 of the Ablee & Risor Property, Lots Nos. 47 and 48 fronting on the North side of Club Drive and Lots Nos. 51, 52, 53 and 54 fronting on the South side of Club Drive, and having such courses and distances as shown on a plat of said property made by Fitzpatrick-Terry Company, Engineers, September 1919 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, page 153, to which reference is hereby made as a part of this description, with the exception that a strip five feet in width extending along Club Drive has been taken off of each of said lots for the purpose of widening Club Drive, and said five foot strip is hereby expressly reserved from this conveyance for said purpose.

Provided that a building line of forty feet shall be maintained and that no dwelling shall be erected thereon costing less than \$4000.00, and that the property shall not be let or sold to any person of African descent.

AND I myself, my heirs, executors and administrators do hereby bind \_\_\_\_\_ warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said A. D. L. Barksdale, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other

person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
