Verdin, All my right title and undivided interest, the same being one-half in fee to all that certain piece parcel and tract of land, situate, lying and being near Batesville, in the County of Greenville, said description was as follows: Beginning at a post oak tree branch and runs thence N. 46 W. 600 feet to an oak tree, joint corner of tracts 3, 3, 4 and 5 in section of public road, thence along the center of said road N. 22 E. 704 1/2 feet to an iron pipe in center of said road in the line of lot No. 1; thence along the line off lot No. 1 S. 71 E. 890 feet to a stake; thence N. 13 3/4 W. 220 feet to a stone; thence S. 60-30 E. 1330 feet to a stone on branch; thence up the mandrel of the branch as a line to the beginning corner and containing fifty-one (51) acres, more or less, all known and designated as tract No. 2 of the Sizemore land as shown by Plat recorded in the R.
