(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mattie Ellis Granger and her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:
"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 174 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Jefferson Howard, Jos. Howard, James Connell, R.E. Johnson and Mrs. Margaret Ballew, consisting of four tracts as follows: 1 Tract containing 60 acres; 1 Tract containing 100 acres; 1 Tract containing 12 acres; 1 Tract containing 2 acres Mill site and more fully described in deed of W.R. Cason to J.W. Dickson dated the 19th day of January, 1916, and recorded in Vol. 39, page 152, to which reference is made as part of the description, and being the same tract of land conveyed to J.R. Watts by W.S. Peck by deed dated December 29, 1920, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, State of South Carolina in Vol. 55, page 336".

Also: "All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about 6 miles East of the City of Greenville and near and South of the Laurens Road, containing 2 Tracts as follows: Tract No. 1, situate on Laurel Creek, containing 61 acres, more or less, and bounded by lands now or formerly owned by Coot-Curston, John Davis, Anderson Wright, Nell Garrett, T.O. Donaldson and Tract No. 1; Tract No. 2, adjoining the above tract, containing 12 acres, more or less, and bounded by lands or formerly owned by Donaldson Wright, Elisha Smith and Cain Franklin, and being the same tract of land conveyed to J.R.
