All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
situate in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina,
City of Greenville on Chicora and Phett
Streets as is shown by a plat made for Thos. M.
Walker Company Aug. 1919 and recorded in P. M. C.
Office for Greenville County in Plat Books "A", "B", "C"
"265 lots nos. 44, 45, 46 & 47 having a frontage on Chicora
Street of 12 feet and rear back to an 18 foot
street; lots nos. 48, 49, 50, 51 and 52 have a frontage each
on Chicora Street of 25 feet with a depth varying
from 79.18 feet to 97.34 feet and lots nos. 60, 61, 62
have a frontage on Phett Street of 25 feet each and
a depth of 95 feet. These lots being part of the
property originally owned by C. H. Terry, also
lot nos. 53 and 54 fronting on Phett Street 22.5 feet
