All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being on the East side of the Augusta Road in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 108 of the Traxler Park Subdivision, as shown on a plat made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, March 1923, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
