The Association, from time to time, may lay out or alter such avenes or walks, or make such rules and regulations for the government of the Cemetery.  7. The prices of lots include all charges for grading and care in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down by the Association and as referred to in Rule No. 10.  8. All sales of lots are made strictly for each, unless in special cases an extension is given by the Association.
