The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is To acquire, own, equip, carry on and conduct a medical and surgical hospital, wherein sick, deformed and injured persons, and maternity patients may be treated and nursed and to make such charges for the care, treatment and board of such persons as the Board of Trustees of this Corporation may deem necessary for the maintenance and upkeep of such hospital, and in connection with its hospital, to carry on a school for nurses if the Corporation so desired. It is the intention that said corporation shall carry on and conduct only a general hospital wherein acute medical and acute surgical patients will be primarily treated, operated on, cared for and nursed.
