EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, B.E. Gear, C.M. McGee and H.L. Stringer, all of Greenville, S.C.

did on the 17th day of May, 1921, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is American Building & Loan Association

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S.C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is that of a general building and

loan association, issuing stock payable in installments or otherwise, providing a means of investing the savings of its stockholders, and enabling its stockholders to borrow money for the erection of homes or investment in real estate, borrowing and lending money, buying, selling, owning and holding real estate, stocks, bonds, notes, mortgages and other evidences of indebtedness and exercising all the rights, powers and privileges conferred upon such associations by the laws of the State of South Carolina.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Two hundred fifty thousand (\$250,000) Dollars: Ultimate, Two Million (\$2,000,000-00) Dollars, payable in cash in instalments or otherwise as the By-Laws may direct.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Initial, 2500, Ultimate 20,000 of the par value of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars each

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the twelfth day of May, 1921 at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

D.W. Cochran, B.E. Gear, C.C. Good, M.B. Leach, H.T. Mills, S.L. McBas, C.M. McGee, L.H. Stringer and J.M. Norris.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President B.E. Gear as Vice-President, L.H. Stringer; as Secretary, add as Treasurer, Chas. H. McGee

NINTH: That all requirements of Chapter XLVII, Article I, of the Civil Code of South Carolina, 1912, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Daily Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W. Banks Dove, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Meane Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.

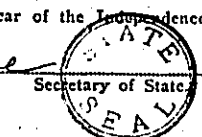
