WHEREAS, *M. A. Allison and R. D. Foxhall*

did on the *30th* day of *January*, 192*2*, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
- SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is *Carolina Piggy Back Stores*
- THIRD: That the principal place of business is *Greenwood, S. C.*

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is *to buy, sell and deal in and with staple and fancy groceries, hay, grain and feed stuffs, either at wholesale or retail, or both, to manufacture, prepare for market and sale of above articles, and all articles necessary or convenient for use in connection with and in carrying on the business; hereinabove mentioned or any part or parts thereof; to buy, sell, own and hold real estate, and to build thereon and otherwise develop and improve the same; to receive and hold on storage food products and other commodities and to issue receipts therefor; to borrow and to lend money and do all things incident to those hereinabove set forth.*

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is *six thousand (6000)* of the par value of *ten (\$10) Dollars.*

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the *30th* day of *January*, 192*2*, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: *M. A. Allison, R. D. Foxhall and A. W. Allison.*

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President *A. W. Allison*, as Vice-President *M. A. Allison*, as Secretary, & Treasurer, *R. D. Foxhall*.

NINTH: That all requirements of Chapter XLVII, Article I, of the Civil Code of South Carolina, 1912, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in *The Columbia Record* a newspaper published in the County of *Richland*.

NOW, THEREFORE, *W. B. Banker Dove* Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is *Twenty thousand (\$20,000.00)* Dollars, payable *cash.*

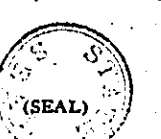
SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is *Two Hundred (200)* of the par value of *One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.*
