describ'd the following tract and boundaries: Beginning at the intersection of Broad and Market streets, and running thence with Broad street *7-13 N. 150 feet* to the corner of lot *5*; thence along the line of this lot *W. 45 E. 50 feet* to the front corner of lots *422 & 23*, and *43*; thence along the line of lot *423 S. 13 E. 150 feet* to the end of street, thence along this street *W. 45 E. 50 feet* to the beginning corner being described in lot *422* as the subdivision of the *W. 45* lines each.
