Know all men by these Presents:
That the Farmers Loan & Trust Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its place of business in the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other valuable Considerations to it cash in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the Woodside Securities Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its place of business in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, and State of South Carolina (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Woodside Securities Company:

1. All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina County of Greenville, and in the City of Greenville on the East side of South Main Street, between Washington Street and 77th Bee Avenue, described by metes and bounds, as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point on South Main Street sixteen feet and eleven inches from the North West corner of the McRay property, and runs thence S. 69^o E. One hundred and fifty nine feet to an alley; thence N. 21^o E. with said alley seven feet; thence N. 69^o W. one hundred and fifty nine feet to a point on Main Street; thence with said Street S. 21^o W. seventeen feet to the beginning corner.
