(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said R.M. Hughes, May H. Garrett and Janie W. Walker,

all that certain lot or parcel of land, situated, lying and being in the town of Greenville, County of Greenville and State aforesaid. Beginning at a stone on Main St. and running N. 60° 2' W. 3.00 to a stone; thence N. 74° 2' W. 4.54 to a stone on New Street; thence S. 15° 2' W. 3.08 to a stone on New Street; thence S. 74° 2' E. 5.50 to a stone in the old miller Road; thence N. 54° E. 50 links to a stone in said old road; thence S. 52° 2' E. 85 links to a stone on main street; thence N. 37° 2' E. 2.41 to the beginning corner containing two and one-fourth acres, more or less, all bounded on the east by main street, on the west by New Street not named, and on the south by lot of J.T. Westmoreland or wife, and on the north by A. Frank Burgess and known as late No. 345 and a half in a survey made by Jas. K. Dickson on the 15th day of December A.D. 1880.
