Graham, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, in the subdivision known as "Kenatamah" and situated on the south side of Oregon Street, and known as Lot #1 of Block "B" on plat of the said property recorded in R.M.C. Office for said County in Plat Book "F", at pp. 66 - 67.

The said lot has the following metes and bounds: beginning at a stake at the southeast corner of Oregon and Mitchell Streets and running along Oregon Street N. 63-30 E. sixty feet to stake at corner of lot #2; thence along said lot S. 26-30 E. one hundred and sixty-five feet to stake; thence S. 63-30 W. sixty feet to stake at corner of said lot #1 and Mitchell Street; thence along Mitchell Street N. 26-30 W. one hundred and sixty-five feet to the beginning corner.
