in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred DOLLARS,

in hand paid to me at and before the sealing of these presents by Jessie L. Craig, of Greenville, in the State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Jessie L. Craig: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, in the subdivision known as "Kanatenah", and situated on the north side of Oregon Street, and known as lot #4 of Block "D", on plat of the said Property recorded in R.M.C. Office for said County in Plat Book "P", at pp. 66 - 67. The said lot has the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on the north side of the said Oregon Street, at the corner of lot #3, recently sold to Nan Sloan, and running thence along said Street N. 63-30 E. sixty feet, to stake at corner of lot #5 in said block; thence along said lot N. 26-30 W. one hundred and sixty-five feet, to stake at corner of lot #12 in said Block; thence along said lot S. 63-30 W. sixty feet to stake at corner of lot #3; thence along said lot S. 26-30 E. one hundred and sixty-five feet to the beginning Point on said Oregon Street.

For value received, Southeastern Life Insurance Company does hereby release and forever relinquish unto the within named Jessie L. Craig, her heirs and assigns, all the land herein described from the lien of two mortgages executed by F.A. Lawton, dated Nov. 17, 1920, and May 6, 1922 and recorded in Volume #33: one at page 186 being given to secure a note in the sum of twenty thousand dollars and one at page 216 to secure a note in the sum of ten thousand dollars. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Jessie L. Craig and her

heirs and assigns, forever.

The grantee, by acceptance of this deed, covenants that she will not construct on said lot any surface closet nor toilet, but only septic tanks or such other sanitary sewers as may be provided by said grantee. This restriction is for the benefit of the other lots in this subdivision.

AND, myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

Jessie L. Craig and her heirs and assigns, against

me and against every person who may hereafter lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
