(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Lenoir A. Mills: All those two certain lots, pieces or parcels of land in the County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, in the subdivision known as "Kanatenah", and known as lots #16 and #17, in Block "E", on revised plat of the said property to be recorded in R.M.C. Office for said County.

The said lots have the following metes and bounds; beginning at a stake on the South side of Cureton Street, at corner of Lot #15 and running thence along said lot 150 feet to stake at corner of lot #8; thence along said lot 110.3 feet to stake on Mitchell Street; thence along said Street, and along a curved drive (connecting Mitchell and Cureton Streets) and along Cureton Street to the beginning point.

For value received, Southeastern Life Insurance Company does hereby release and forever relinquish unto the within named Lenoir A.
