Petty, all of our interest in a certain parcel or tract of land, situated lying and being in the state and County aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds, Beginning on a stone near the back of Mrs. Mary Sister spring branch, just below Mrs. Mary Sister spring and running thence with said Spring branch to its confluence with Fortenberry's Branch.
