(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the  
said B. L. Blackland and J. R. Moran, All that lot, parcel or tract of land,  
in said state and County, being known as a part of the  
M. D. Jones tract, the sub-division of which is recorded in Plat  
Book "E" at page 218 of R. M. C. Office for Greenville County  
and being a part of the land conveyed to us by deed  
recorded in Vol. 87 at page 77 of said R. M. C. Office and  
generally described as follows:  
Beginning at a stake on the Augusta Road 288 feet from  
the sidewalk corner, and running thence S. 60° 45' W. 1074 feet  
more or less to the old Augusta Road; and thence along the  
old Augusta Road to the corner of the lot heretofore conveyed  
by us to M. M. Jones by deed recorded in said R. M. C. Office  
in Vol. 87 at page 289 and thence along the line of said lot  
conveyed to the said M. M. Jones, 900 feet more or less to the  
Augusta Road; and thence along the Augusta Road 29.10  
ft. 225 feet more or less, to the beginning corner; and it is  
hereby understood and agreed that twenty-five (25) feet of  
the road hereby conveyed beginning at the Augusta Road and  
extending along the said road adjacent to the lot heretofore conveyed  
to the said M. M. Jones is excepted and reserved for street  
purposes for the use and benefit of themselves, their heirs  
and assigns in conjunction with and supplemental to the  
reservations and exceptions for the same purpose and road  
part of the same street of a strip of land twenty-five feet  
wide along the same line from the said lot conveyed to the  
said Jones.

120 heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
