said P. P. Vaughan, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, in the subdivision known as "Kenatenah", and known as Lot #4 of Block "E", on Revised plat of the said property to be recorded in R.M.C. Office for said County.

The said lot has the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on the North side of Stewart Street, at corner of Lot #3, and running thence with said Street 60 feet to stake at corner of lot #5; thence along said lot 150 feet to stake at corner of lot #12; thence along said lot, 50 feet to stake at corner of lot #3; thence along said lot, 150 feet to the beginning point on said Stewart Street.
