Norwood, All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being on the South side of College Street, in Ward One of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having according to a survey made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, in July 1923, the following notes and bounds, to-wit:
Commencing at an iron pipe on the south side of College Street, corner of E.F. Bates property thence along E.F. Bates' line and along west edge of a brick wall S. 20-54 W. 100 feet to an iron pipe; thence along rear line parallel to College Street N. 58-01 W. 25 feet to an iron pipe; thence along line of grantors N. 20-54 E. 100 feet to an iron pipe on the South side of College Street; thence along the south side of College Street S. 58-01 E. 25 feet to the point of beginning.

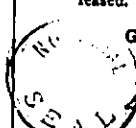
