(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the
John A. Russell and John W. Lipscomb and their heirs and assigns, All that certain lot,
piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, in the
County and Township of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, having the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:-
Beginning at a stake on the southwest corner of lot conveyed by me to the said John A. Russell
and John W. Lipscomb by deed recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for
said County and State in Deed Book 82, at page 130 (said stake being forty feet southward
from the south side of the Easley Bridge Road and about thirty-eight and a quarter feet
eastward from the east side of Georgia Avenue), and running thence along the line of the lot
above mentioned N. 71° E. thirty (30) feet to the south-east corner of said lot; thence
S. 11° E. thirty six (36) feet along line of a lot conveyed by me to John A. Russell by
deed recorded in said office in Book 78, at page 352 to the north line of a strip of land
nine feet in width belonging to me (over which I granted to the said John A. Russell by the
deed last above mentioned a right-of-way to Georgia Avenue); thence along the north side
of said nine foot strip S. 71° W. thirty (30) feet to a stake; thence approximately N. 11°
W. thirty-six (36) feet to the beginning corner.
The lot hereby conveyed is a portion of Lot "I-3" of West Highland as shown on plat thereof
made by W.D. Neves, dated January 24, 1916 and recorded in said office in Plat Book "C"
at page 258. Said lot "I-3" was conveyed to me by Mrs. Susan H. Pilcher by deed dated
February 21, 1919, and recorded in said office in Book 53, at page 54.
