(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

H. A. Schubelge,  
all that pieces, parcels and lot of land in the County  
and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville,  
in the subdivision known as "Kanatalah" and com-  
posed of two lots known as # 15 and # 16 in Block  
# 1, and received plat of the said property. The said  
lot has the following metes and bounds, beginning  
at the stake at the N.W. corner of lot # 15, on Glassine  
Street, and running thence along said street  
N. 63-35-6° 116.8 feet to stake at corner of lot # 17,  
thence along said lot S. 25-51-6° 159.7 feet to stake  
at corner of lot # 2, thence along # 2, due # 1, 118.4  
feet to stake and line on the Lawton property thence  
N. 25-51-W 159.7 feet to the beginning point on  
Glassine Street.
