unto the said.

W.D. Parrish and T.C. Gower, their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:
"All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, on
the West side of Jones Avenue and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at a stake at the intersection of Jones Avenue and proposed street dividing lands
of Stella K. Tindal and W.B. McDaniel, being the southwest corner of said intersecting Streets,
and running thence with Jones Avenue S. 0-35 W. 60 feet to a stake; thence N. 85-15 E. 170 feet
to stake; thence N. 0-35 E. 60 feet to stake on proposed Street; thence with proposed Street S.
85-15 W. 170 feet to the beginning."
