I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, H.C. Wood

on or about the 16th day of May in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-two exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against W.P. Neal

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 10th day of July 1922, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, That I, E. Inman Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty-seven hundred (\$2700.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said W.R. Stewart

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said.

W.R. Stewart and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: "All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid in the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at the southern corner of David and Stall Streets; thence with Stall Street S. 66 1/4 W. 80 feet to a stake, corner of Emmett Williams; thence with line of Emmett Williams S. 23-3/4 E. 120 feet to a stake; thence N. 66 1/4 E. 80 feet to David Street; thence with David Street N. 23-3/4 W. 120 feet to the beginning corner."

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned, unto the said W.R. Stewart and his

heirs and assigns forever.
