on or about the 18th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and nineteen exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Yancy Carter et al.

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, That I, E. Inman Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said Robert Gray

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said.

Robert Gray and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the Southern part of the city of Greenville, County and state, aforesaid on the west side of the C. & G. Railway and on the south side of St. John street and being known and designated as lot No. 2 of the estate of Ella Casley, as shown by a sub-division and plat of same, made by P. C. Dalton, Engineer in March 1923, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as will appear by reference to said plat, to-wit:
Beginning at an old pin on the south side of St. John Street, 36.4 feet from the center of the C. & G. Division of the Southern Railway, and running thence S. 33.10 W. 107.8 feet to stake in line of the Wesley Reed property; thence along the line of last mentioned property N. 75.18 W. 37 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot No. 1; thence along the line of last mentioned lot, N. 16.38 E. 102.4 feet to an iron pin in line of St. John street thence along the line of St. John street S. 75.15 E. 67.5 feet to the beginning corner and bounded by St. John street, C. & G.
