unto the said.

R. D. Dobson and his heirs and assigns forever, the follow-  
ing described real estate:  
"All that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying  
and being in the State and County aforesaid, within  
the town of Greer, on Frohawk St. Beginning at M. B.  
Littlefield's corner on said Frohawk St. and running  
thence with said Street 120 feet westward; thence  
Northward 135 feet with R. D. Dobson line; thence  
120 feet Eastward with M. D. Littlefield line; thence  
135 feet Southward with M. D. Littlefield line to their  
beginning corner, bounded by lands of M. D. Littlefield
