to it in hand paid by the Southern Power Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said Southern Power Company

its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that tract of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of Judson Mills and connecting to the Dunear-Judson line at the Easley Bridge Road and running North 9° 32' W. to a point; thence N. 33 47' E. to a point on the Mill Village Road; thence S. 81 35' E. to the property of the Piedmont Plush Mills, more particularly shown on Blue Print attached hereto.
