of said County and State, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar and other considerations Dollars,

to him in hand paid by the Southern Power Company the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said Southern Power Company

and upon that tract of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of Riverside Land Co., Union Bleachery and others and to construct and maintain in, upon and thru said Premises in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires, and other necessary apparatus and appliances, two lines of structures, for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, and supporting telephone wires; together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; said two lines of structures to be parallel to each other, and the center lines of same to be not more than sixty (60) feet apart, and to be constructed of either towers or poles (whether wooden, steel or concrete), which may be changed from one to the other, from time to time, at the option of the Southern Power Company; and with the right to make such changes, alterations, and substitutions in said lines or structures, from time to time, as the grantee herein may deem advisable or expedient; together with the right to keep said right of way clear of all structures for the space of thirty-four feet (34) on each side of the center of said power lines; with the further right to cut away and keep clear of said lines and wires all trees or other like obstructions that might in any way endanger the proper operation of same

and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said premises in proper manner with poles, towers, wires, and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right, at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other like obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.
