(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. M. Bennett, R. W. Arlington, G. Wallace, G. F. White and C. P. Hutchings Trustees Parker School District, their successors

and assigns, forever, two lots of land situate in the County and State aforesaid in the town of West Greenville, and on the north side of Puddleton Street being a part of the lands belonging to Davis Furman and H. J. Hayneworth and formerly known as Arlington Height and numbered on a plat made by J. C. Southern in 1790 as lot 1 and three rods of said lots fronting 50 feet on Puddleton Street and extending back to an alley or yard plot. Said lots adjoin each other and together have the following lines and distances.

Bounding at a stake on Puddleton St. corner of lot No. 11 reserved by Davis Furman and H. J. Hayneworth to lot 11 there is a westerly direction with Puddleton Street 100 feet to corner of lot No. 1 heretofore conveyed by Davis Furman and H. J. Hayneworth to J. S. Clark, thence in a northerly direction with line of lot No. 1 205 feet more or less to line of alley and back to said yard or back plot. Thence in an easterly direction with line of said alley 100 feet to corner of lot No. 11, thence with line of lot No. 4 208 feet, more or less to the beginning corner.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by Davis Furman and H. J. Hayneworth on the 8th day of February 1919, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 24, Page 250, TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

P. Hutchings Trustees Parker School District, their successors and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
