the undersigned hereby acknowledge, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
E.P. Grant: All that certain lot of land situate in the County and State aforesaid,
and being more particularly described as follows:
Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Bunccombe Road, being the southeast corner
of a lot owned by J.W. Styles; thence with Bunccombe Road, South 4 degrees 17 minutes,
East 115 feet to an iron pin; thence North 87 degrees and 40 minutes East 207.4 feet
to an iron pin; thence South 4 degrees and 17 minutes East one hundred and five feet to
an iron pin; thence North 87 degrees and 40 minutes East 207.4 feet to an iron pin; thence
along Bunccombe Road, North 4 degrees and 47 minutes East one hundred five feet to iron
pin, being the beginning point of the lot now hereby conveyed by this deed, containing
one-half acre, more or less.

The above described land is the same conveyed to us by Lee Woodall, H.S. Allen and E.P.
