This Memorandum of agreement made and entered into this 21st, day of April, 1924, by and between C.R. Stone and J.C. Keys, witnesseth:

That for and in consideration of the price of Ninety-seven hundred dollars, payable as hereinafter stated, C.R. Stone agrees to convey to J.C. Keys by fee simple title, with full warranty, free of encumbrance, that lot of land in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, on the North side of Earle Street, fronting one hundred feet, more or less, on Farle Street, running back through the block a depth of four hundred sixteen feet, more or less, to Croft Street, and having a frontage of one hundred feet, more or less, on Croft Street, lying between property of R.G. Stone and Dr. Geo. T. Walker and E.E. Stone.

J.C. Keys agrees to pay for the lot above described as follows, Two hundred dollars cash, five hundred dollars July 1, 1924 and the balance nine thousand dollars on or before November 1, 1924. Deferred payments shall not bear interest. Should purchaser desire to comply with this contract prior to November 1, 1924, upon tender of payment of the balance due on the purchase price. J.C. Keys agrees to pay fifteen dollars on the 1924 taxes and C.R. Stone agrees to pay the balance-To the faithful performance of this agreement the parties hereto bind themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
