Upon reading the petition of A.D.L. Barksdale, Trustee in the above matter, and the report of E.M. Blythe, Esq., Referee in Bankruptcy, herewith filed, and it appearing unto the Court that the real estate hereinbelow described passed to the Trustee as part of the assets of the bankrupt estate.

An Appraisal was made by the duly appointed appraisors, Messrs. John W. Lipscomb, S.C. Templeton and J.M. Rose, reputable business men of Greenville, S.C., in whom both the Trustee and the Referee expressed full confidence, and the value of the property was placed at \$12,500.00. There is an outstanding mortgage executed by the bankrupt's predecessor in title, J.A. Bull, in favor of the Greenville Building & Loan Association for the original sum of \$3,500.00, but on which there is now due as principal and interest the sum of approximately \$9,700.00. This lien is recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Vol. 99 at page 90 of Real Estate mortgages.

It appears that numerous efforts to dispose of the property have been made by the Trustee.
