Herbert Cope, did this day appear before me and upon being privately and separately examined by me did declare that she does freely voluntarily and without any compulsion, fear or dread of any person or persons whomsoever, renounce, release and forever relinquish unto Annie W. Cureton and her heirs and assigns, all her interest and estate and also all her right and claim of dower, in or to all and singular the premises described as follows:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the First Ward of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of Hampton Avenue, on the southwest corner of an alley twenty (20) feet wide, which runs along the west side of a lot conveyed by Mrs. Harriet B. McBee to Eliza T. McBee, and running thence along said Hampton Avenue N. 43 degrees W. seventy-seven and one-half ($77\frac{1}{2}$) feet to corner of lot formerly belonging to W.A. Briggs; thence with line of said Briggs' lot N. 43 degrees E. two hundred and twenty-two (222) feet to line of land now or formerly belonging to the said Mrs. Harriet B. McBee; thence along said line S. 43 degrees E. sixty-six (66) feet to said twenty foot alley; thence along said alley S. $38\frac{1}{2}$ degrees W. two hundred and twenty-two (222) feet to the beginning corner on Hampton Avenue.

Being the same lot conveyed by J. Herbert Cope to Mrs. F.M. Cope by deed dated November 11, 1907 and recorded in Volume VVV, at page 677 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
