Batson full power and authority to execute in our names a contract conveying unto the City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon the tract of land situate in Bates Township, said County and State, bounded by lands of Wesley Batson on the North, by lands of Grover Bates on the East, by lands of the Jisses West, on the South and by lands of Vernon Bates on the West (about 114 acres).
(The damages and right of way covered by this agreement are for pipe line marked "plain line" according to survey of Ludlow Engineers.)

Batson full power and authority to execute whatever contract is necessary and usual for the purpose of conveying said easement, and hereby authorize said City of Greenville to pay to Mrs. Susan Batson, T.Y. Batson and J.L. Batson, the full amount of the consideration for said contract.
