All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, known and designated as lot No. 11 in Block "A" of the subdivision known as Augusta Court, as shown on a plat of record in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in the Plat Book "F," page 124, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the northwest side of the New Street running through this subdivision at corner of Lot No. 10 and running thence with the Street line along a curve to the right 185.7 feet; thence still with Street line N. 39-33 W. 75.1 feet to stake corner of Lot No. 12; thence with line of Lot No. 12 N. 52-03 E. 118.2 feet to stake corner of Lot No. 10; thence with line of lot No. 10, S. 37-57 E. 199.4 feet to the beginning.

(2) The facing of the lots as shown on said plat shall be strictly adhered to, however, more than one lot may be used for the purpose of erecting a dwelling.
(3) The property herein conveyed shall never be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to Negroes or persons having any percentage of Negro blood.
(4) No out-building shall be erected nearer to the abutting sidewalks than thirty (30) feet.

And I do hereby bind myself, as Trustee, and my successors in office, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said L. A. Mills and his Heirs and Assigns, against myself, as Trustee, and my successors in office, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
