Manos, the wife of A. K. Manos, the grantor in a deed to a lot of land hereinafter more specifically indicated, did this day appear before me, and upon being privately and separately examined by me did declare that she does freely, voluntarily and without compulsion, dread or fear of any person or persons, whatsoever renounce, release, and forever relinquish unto Dexter Land Company, the grantee mentioned in said deed, its successors and assigns all her interest and estate, and also all her right and claim of dower of, in or to all and singular the said premises mentioned and released in said deed, to-wit: that lot of land situated on the west side of Main Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having a frontage of Twenty four (24) feet on said Street, with a depth of one hundred (100) feet, and being more specifically described in a certain deed made by A.
