Whereas, Southern Public Utilities Company a corporation, owns, maintains and operates a dam and power plant on Saluda River, known as Saluda Dam, which power dam backs water in Saluda River and tributaries; and

whereas I, (Mrs.) C. Melissa Farr, am the owner in fee simple of a one-half undivided interest in certain lands situated in Greenville County, South Carolina, on Saluda River and have filed suit against the Southern Public Utilities Company, which suit is now pending in the United States District Court, Western District of South Carolina on account of damages caused to my said lands by said backwaters, and by the filling in of the bed of the stream with mud, sand etc, and,

whereas, the parties have reached a satisfactory agreement concerning said matter:

Now, Therefore, know all men by these presents, that I, (Mrs.) C. Melissa Farr of the county and state aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars to me in hand paid by the Southern Public Utilities Company, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Southern Public Utilities Company, the right so far as all of my lands affected by the said backwaters, among others, embracing a tract of land situate in Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on Saluda River, being the lands conveyed to me and to my husband, William B. Farr, by deed dated September 4, 1879, as tenants in common, said deed being duly recorded in office of Register Menze Conveyances, Greenville County South Carolina in volume H. 76, at page 502, the said William B. Farr having previously conveyed his interest to the grantor herein.

To have and to hold all and singular the rights, easements and privileges before mentioned unto the said Southern Public Utilities Company, its successors and assigns forever.

And I do by these presents release and forever discharge the said Southern Public Utilities Company, its successors and assigns,
