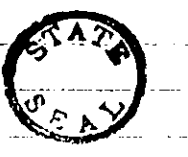

Demer. Sub. District Committee of Greenville in the State aforesaid, to have, hold, exercise  
and enjoy the said office of member of Committee aforesaid, together with all the  
rights, privileges, profits and emoluments whatsoever thereunto belonging,  
or in anywise appertaining.

This Commission is to continue in force for the term provided by law (6 years).
