I, reposing special trust and confidence in your ability, care, prudence and integrity, have commissioned, constituted and appointed, and by these Presents do commission, constitute and appoint you the said Carl L. Gullick, Member Parker Water and Sewer Sub. District Committee of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, to have, hold, exercise enjoy the said office of member of Committee aforesaid, together with all the rights, privileges, profits and emoluments whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining.

This commission is to continue in force for the term provided by law. (4 years).
