Release.

For and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, and certain other valuable consideration known to the parties, (receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), The First National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, a Corporation, does hereby forever release the Greater Greenville Sewer District, a Corporation, of Greenville, South Carolina, from any and all claims for damages, or any kind of claims of whatsoever kind and description by reason of any damage or injury done, if done, past, present and future by reason of the erection and maintenance of the sewer disposal plant of said Greater Greenville Sewer District located near the property of the said First National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, a Corporation, particularly on account of obnoxious odors, and any other caused, to the property of the First National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, a Corporation, located nearby, and more particularly the following described piece of property:-

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 63.35 acres, more or less, and fronting 653.5 feet on the Augusta Road, adjoining lands of Julia D. Charles and Aug W. Smith, and being more fully described in a plat of the lands of Milton S. Smith, made August 1923, by R. E. Dalton Engineer, and being the remaining half of the tract of land containing 126.70 acres, more or less, conveyed to The First National Bank, a Corporation, by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated February 21, 1931, and recorded in the R. M. O. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 140, Page 249, the remaining half thereof having been this day conveyed to the Greater Greenville Sewer District a Corporation."

This release shall be binding on said First National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, a Corporation, its successors and assigns.
